

This year's theme, The Diaspora: Accelerating U.S.-Africa Trade, Investment, and Technological Innovation, highlights the significant role of the African Diaspora in catalyzing U.S.-Africa Trade, economic, and cultural engagement.

In 2002, in partnership with the African Union, The Foundation for Democracy in Africa (FDA) organized the 1st African Union (AU) Western Hemisphere Africa Diaspora Conference at Howard University in Washington, DC, under the theme, The Future of Africa. This robust engagement led to a technical workshop in Port of Spain hosted by the government of Trinidad and Tobago, the AU, and the FDA on the definition of the African Diaspora and the inclusion of the African Diaspora under article 3q of the African Union Constitutive Act during the AU Heads of State Summit.

Recently, the White House announced the President's Advisory Council on African Diaspora Engagement. The inaugural council of twelve is to advise President Biden and future U.S. Presidents on reinforcing cultural, social, political, and economic ties between the U.S. and Africa and promoting trade, investment, and educational exchanges between the U.S. and Africa; a welcome endorsement of Article 3q of the African Union Constitutive Act of 2003.

The African Diaspora in the U.S. is a source of strength. It encompasses African Americans, including descendants of enslaved Africans and two million African immigrants, and they are critical to advancing trade, investment, and cultural ties between the U.S. and Africa and advocacy efforts to extend and enhance the African Growth and Opportunity Act (AGOA) beyond 2025.

I invite you to join us for the Diaspora Town Hall Meeting on Friday, October 27, 2023, for a dynamic discussion entitled *The Future is Now for Diaspora Investment and Engagement in Africa*.

I congratulate our 2023 Medal of Glory Award (MOGA) Honorees. #### **ABOUT AIBD SA**

Since its establishment in 2006, AIBD SA has been tasked with the financing, construction, operation, maintenance, and expansion of the new Diass airport, which was officially opened on December 7th, 2017. AIBD SA is owned by the Government of Senegal.Blaise Diagne International Airport is managed by LAS (Limak - AIBD SA - Summa), with AIBD.SA holding a 34% ownership stake, while the remaining 13 regional airports are directly overseen by AIBD SA.

Presently, this publicly traded company is also responsible for the management, refurbishment, enhancement, and growth of a network comprising 13 regional airports. Its objective is to transform Senegal into the primary air transportation hub in West Africa by 2035. This will be achieved by establishing a dynamic and interconnected system of 13 modern airports, accompanied by the development of appealing business parks in their vicinity. In doing so, AIBD SA is contributing to the goals of Plan Sénégal Émergent (PSE), which aims to position Senegal as a prominent economic and cultural hub in West Africa. A team of around 800 individuals across Senegal is committed to "building the future" and turning these ambitions into reality. They are driven by a shared set of values, including a strong sense of duty, commitment to quality, innovation, precision, and solidarity.
