AfrICANDO Opening Ceremony Keynote of Abdoulaye DIEYE, CEO of AIBD.SA /SENEGAL

- The construction of an Maintenance Repair Overhaul Center covering an area of 10,000 square meters, designed to serve the national carrier, Air Senegal, and other international airlines;
- The International Academy of Civil Aviation Professions (AIMAC) with two campuses, providing cutting-edge training techniques and EASA and IATA certifications. The Academy has already begun its activities, training student pilots and aeronautical maintenance technicians;
- The development of a new cargo terminal and a Center of Medical Expertise for Aviation Personnel to make the airport a hub for medical tourism.

In its phase of growth, AIBD will capitalize on its advantageous geographic location by focusing on the "passenger experience" to enhance the airport's attractiveness.

In this context, the Airport City initiative enables AIBD to utilize its 2,000-hectares land reserve for developing industrial service infrastructure in the vicinity of the airport.

AIBD SA also includes an interconnected network of 13 regional airports that have the capacity to host direct flight routes for airlines, complemented by attractive tourist attractions.

Looking ahead, a promising future is unfolding for Senegal's civil aviation through the Senegal Airports Reconstruction Program, often referred to as PRAS, and the 2021-2025 Air Hub strategy. This strategic initiative, a central component of the Emerging Senegal Plan, is characterized by its unparalleled scale and breadth.

If our country anticipates the development of national and international traffic, it is because favorable economic growth prospects, combined with the imminent and large-scale exploitation of oil and gas, will make Senegal, the gateway to West Africa, a preferred destination for foreign investors.

All the regional airport platforms targeted by this ambitious project will boost Senegal's international attractiveness, generate economic growth, and serve as a vital driver for domestic air connectivity. AIBD will be at the core of this unprecedented transformation of Senegal's skies, in line with the vision of the President of the Republic, His Excellency Macky Sall, whose commitment to the radiance and development of Senegal is intrinsic to his political engagement.

Ladies and gentlemen, for various reasons, this is why we are actively taking part in this conference and exhibition, which is proving to be a significant platform for us to present the business prospects available in the hospitable land. It goes beyond our organization and resonates on a global scale.

I extend an invitation for you to explore our booth, where you can delve further into our projects and engage in more in-depth discussions with my team. To conclude, I would like to express my gratitude once again and offer my congratulations to the FDA for their outstanding organization, and I wish every success to the conference proceedings.
