

USTDA IIS TRADE AND DEVELOPMENT AGENCY

- USTDA awarded a grant to Senegal's national utility – Société Nationale d'Electricité (Senelec) – for training program supplied by Illinois-based Weldy Lamont Associates.
- Senelec's investment in power grid technology helps bring power to 440,000 people in rural communities.
- Project financed by the Export-Import Bank of the United States
- Supports approximately 500 U.S. jobs across 10 States.
- Project supports the U.S. government's Power Africa and Prosper Africa Initiatives.
